

## **Pine Tree Water Control District Policy on Canal Crossings**

### **Canal Crossings**

The Pine Tree Water Control District (PTWCD) is responsible for the maintenance of five (5) canals within the Rustic Ranches subdivision. Maintaining the flow of water through those canals is a PTWCD goal. The construction of a canal crossing without the express written consent and approval of the PTWCD is strictly prohibited.

The landowner shall submit engineered drawings as required by the District Engineer after approval of the conceptual crossing by the PTWCD Board. The submittal shall be reviewed and is subject to approval in the form of a permit with conditions by the PTWCD Engineer. The permit approved by the Engineer shall be brought back to the PTWCD Board for ratification. The size of the culvert shall be specified by the PTWCD. Should a permit be approved, ongoing maintenance is the responsibility of the landowner.

In the event of the construction of an unpermitted canal crossing, without limiting other remedies, the PTWCD may remove the crossing and assess the responsible landowner for the cost of the removal.
